

# "DragCon 11" - Plastic Model Contest

Presented by the Draggins Rod & Custom Car Club and the Scale Modellers Association of Saskatoon  
(SMAS)

## Categories and General Rules.

Models must have been built from plastic or resin kits, or scratch-built from plastic/resin materials and must be the sole work of the entrant.

Metal die-cast models of any kind are not accepted in the contest.

Junior entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian confirming the model is the work of the entrant.

Judges reserve the right to question any entrant on methods used in the construction.

Instruction sheets for each entry should be made available for the judges if requested.

SMAS members will be judging the "PRIZE DIVISION" and SMAS Senior members will not be eligible for awards in that division. Models built by SMAS members are only eligible for "SPONSOR CHOICE" awards.

There are two "DIVISIONS" as noted below.

## A - "PRIZE DIVISION"

- The primary model category is the "PRIZE DIVISION", for which only models of cars and trucks, built to 1/24<sup>th</sup> and 1/25<sup>th</sup> scales are accepted.
- For the PRIZE DIVISION only, there are three age groups ;
- **1A : Junior One : Up to grade 8**
- **2A : Junior Two : Grades 9 to 12**
- **3A to 3E : Senior.**

SENIOR PRIZE DIVISION DETAILS - This division has FIVE model classes:

- **3A : Showroom Stock (Out-of-the-Box)\***
- **3B : Showroom Stock (Detailer)\*\***
- **3C : Working and Weathered Vehicles \*\*\***
- **3D : Racers \*\*\***
- **3E : Hot Rods and Show Cars \*\*\***

### **\* 3A: Showroom Stock (Out-of-the -Box)**

- Any automotive vehicle sold to the general public by any auto manufacturer for **public street** use i.e. GM, Ford, Toyota, Ferrari, etc, using kit supplied numbered styrene plastic parts/decals ONLY. Tires supplied as part of the kits must also be used. Painting is allowed as is the use of metal foil for existing trim/mouldings. Kit

instructions shall be made available to the judges by builder if requested, in order to resolve any conflicts.

- **NOTE:** The use of resin and/or metal photo etch parts, even where supplied with the kit, requires the model to be entered in the Detailer class.

**\*\* 3B : Showroom Stock (Detailer)**

- Any automotive vehicle sold to the general public by any auto manufacturer for **public street** use i.e. GM, Ford, Toyota, Ferrari, etc. Modifications, substitution of parts, wiring and plumbing, painting and decals to any level of detail are allowed. Detailing parts may be plastic, resin, metal photo-etch and fabric.

**\*\*\* 3C, 3D and 3E**

Unrestricted detailing is allowed for **Workplace/Weathered, Racer, Rod & Show** classes.

- Detailing parts may be plastic, resin, metal photo-etch, tape, paper, fabric etc.

**B - Class 4 - The "GENERAL DIVISION", all age groups and land vehicles.**

Cars and trucks in scales other than 1/24<sup>th</sup> and 1/25<sup>th</sup>, motorcycles, vehicles with tracks and other types of land vehicles may be entered and will be eligible for "**SPONSOR CHOICE AWARDS**". This class may include awards such as "CORKS CUSTOM CHOICE", "TIMS CHOICE" and so on. It is expected that an employee or other representative of the sponsor will choose the winner, with no involvement by SMAS.

All models in Class 4, whether "OUT-OF-THE BOX" or "DETAILED" are in the same category.

**NOTES**

Models in the PRIZE DIVISION are also eligible for SPONSOR CHOICE AWARDS.

Models that are pre-finished by the kit manufacturer, either with paint or decals, will be deducted the maximum number of points in the "Finish" category.

Diorama or other display bases **will not exceed 24" by 24"** of table top space. Any number of models may be included in a display. Points will not be awarded for the diorama or display base itself. 110v electrical power **will not** be available for turntables, lighting or any similar electrical features. Battery powered effects are permitted.
